



Raynes Park Vale FC COVID Guidelines for the 20-21 Season (SUBJECT TO CHANGE IN LINE WITH GOVERNMENT UPDATES)

As a result of Coronavirus, we have had to implement various measures to ensure the safety of all players, staff, match officials, committee members, volunteers and spectators (in due course). As a result, please ensure you adhere to the guidelines below in anticipation of visiting our ground at Grand Drive.

1. Match officials should have self-assessed before travelling to a match. This includes assessing whether they are suffering from any COVID symptoms (including continuous coughing, loss of taste or sense of smell) on the day of the event. Should the official self-assess themselves as having the risk of carrying Coronavirus or displaying any of the COVID symptoms, they should not attend the ground and instead inform the relevant club staff as soon as possible.
2. Match officials must comply with all aspects of the FA guidance attached to this documentation and complied with all relevant aspects of the guidance required, prior to travel. Match officials over the age of 50 years will be asked to wear a face covering on entry to the ground.
3. Track and trace information must be provided upon entry. This information will be securely held and confidentially destroyed after 21 days has elapsed.
4. Match officials will be required to use the sanitiser available immediately on entry to the ground and to use it from time to time to help protect themselves as well as others.
5. Match officials should 'bring their own water bottle, clearly marked, to be for **their use ONLY**.
